Siblings in Christ,

This Lenten Season let us not necessarily give anything up but rather let us take something meaningful on. For the Lord our God has proclaimed in Isaiah 58: 6-7:

<sup>7</sup> Is it not to share your bread with the hungry, and bring the homeless poor into your house; when you see the naked, to cover them, and not to hide yourself from your own kin?

Yes, it may be that others need to hear the gospel message from you that Jesus Saves! Bring to light the good news to another that His arms are open wide to embrace them in love as this other would have a change of heart about who should be in control of the life that they live. As you have opportunity express to others who are suffering in pain the words that "God's Way is the Best Way" to live this life. Ask them to make Jesus their Lord and Savior through surrender of their will to His will. Let them know that this is all that it takes, a surrender to Him. Jesus will show them the Way, the Truth, and the Life as that is exactly who Jesus is.



The following funds have been approved: General Fund, Camp Scholarship Fund, Capital Repair and Improvement Fund, Good Samaritan/Mission Fund, and Noah/Rainy Day Fund.

#### **Disbursement Procedures**

Procedures for disbursing funds and assigning authority to the treasurer for regular financial transactions in alignment with the Book of Discipline.

#### **Event Counting Procedure**

Procedures for handling money collected at activities, events or other ministries conducted in the name and for the benefit of TUMC.
