



What to Expect

What restrictions are being imposed due to the COVID pandemic?

You will be asked to maintain a distance of six feet between you and any other person who is not a family member. Family members may sit together, side by side. All individuals will be asked to wear masks and to wash their hands frequently and use hand sanitizer.

Currently, the service is being held in the Social Hall on the lower level. Handicapped access is available. You will be asked to sign in just inside the entrances. You will not receive a bulletin but a step-by-step order of service will be projected on the screen at the front of the seating area.

What Time Should I Arrive?

Our Sunday worship service begins at 9:30 am. We suggest you arrive 5-10 minutes prior to the start of the service. (Our online service starts at 9 am.)

What Should I Wear?

We care about *you*, not what you're wearing. You will find everything from business suits to casual shorts, so wear what is comfortable for you.

What Should I Expect During Worship?

You can expect to find someone at the door to greet you and answer any questions you may have.

The worship service will last approximately one hour.

Currently, offering plates will not be passed. Instead, you will be asked to put your contribution in the basket just inside the Social Hall.

What is Available For My Children During Worship?

Your children are welcome to sit with you throughout our service. There are bags with coloring pages, crayons and books available to keep them occupied during the service if needed. Ask a greeter or an usher for a bag.

Are There Sunday School Classes?

Typically, Sunday School classes run from September through May. Currently, because of coronavirus concerns, no Sunday School classes are meeting.
